CASE STORY

- Shashikala Headmistress, GHS Haragadde

"Namasthe. I'm Shashikala, Haragadde High School's headmistress. I've been working at this school since 2021, and when I first arrived, there was no proper bathroom or hand washing station. We only had two toilets here, both of which were broken due to the lack of water and bad management. There were no properly functioning doors or taps. Girls, in particular, had a lot of trouble using these kinds of toilets, which presented a significant difficulty for me as the school's headmistress. When Prema from SOCHARA came to visit our school, she talked with me and conducted a need-based assessment; throughout the visit, I told Prema about the challenges. Prema followed up on information and went to the BEO office to obtain a construction permit. She devoted a lot of time and effort behind the building of new toilets. Her efforts are much appreciated by me. Finally, the SOCHARA C-Wash team built beautiful toilets in the school premises. It is an incredible present for our school. This excellent act benefited around 330 kids and staff. I am grateful to the entire SOCHARA team."





GEARING UP FOR BETTER AND SAFER FUTURE - PROGRESS AND QUESTIONS

SOCHARA C-Wash Chennai Team is conducting regular visits to MKB Nagar Police club to oversee the progress of the toilet construction. The construction is taking its pace with imminent support from the community and the scoutmaster alike. The team also interacted with the community in our field visits to understand their concerns on the vaccination that is now being administered for children. The community raised their concerns on the absence of nearby vaccination camps. They are sceptical about getting the children of 12-18 years old vaccinated. They also said that they have not received any public awareness campaign by the government regarding the vaccination for children yet. The team and the community have met with an unprecedented challenge on the ground which calls for a halt in the infrastructure developments in Saidapet Police club. Scoutmaster Geetha had updated the team on the recently received Slum Clearance and Demolition notice by the Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board. The team made field visits to the club to discuss the issue in detail with the scoutmaster and the community. The slum clearance board notice specifies that the housing board inhabitants have 3 months to vacate their homes and plan a shift. It also mentions that any inconveniences or property loss post the three months Notice period will not be the government's responsibility.

Scoutmaster Geetha, on receival of the notice, had consulted the Sub Inspector of Police the same day before the team's visit. Inspector notified that the Police Club building comes under the area of housing board and hence will be demolished. The team extended support to the community. A plausible solution to the issue is under discussion.







CELEBRATING OUR INCREDIBLE WOMEN - INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY

Local empowered women assembling a Street play team and performing was the highlight of the two-day programme; we notice a lot of bright women in the group who can contribute in building their own community.


