Over the past six decades there is an increased understanding of the health outcomes of tobacco The Doll Peto use. and epidemiological study of the 1950s in the UK established a causal association between tobacco use and cancer. Subsequently thousands of studies across the world. including in India, established links between all forms of tobacco use and adverse health outcomes. SOCHARA and other NGO partners from Bengaluru to understand the various complexities involved in the health situation of one of the most marginalized sections of society the slum dwellers in Bengaluru city.

A slum is perhaps a generic term that refers to the settlement options available for the urban poor. The resident populations include skilled and unskilled labour; the backbone of the trade and construction sector. While we may opt to neglect these settlements, slums have a high prevalence of infectious diseases and are also more vulnerable to chronic diseases, such as cardiovascular diseases and cancers. | Read>>
