


# **Understanding the determinants of MDGs**

# A Peoples Court Health and Development Tribunals - India




# Attended by members of the community / civil society

 Ordinary village activists and local people can audit health systems with proper orientation and simple tools – and development systems too!


- Peoples evidence strong on corruption, gender discrimination, social exclusion, stigma and system defaults

- Lead to deeper understanding of structural /systemic obstacles to development


